The buyer acknowledges that the seller, Max Baron Dobermans - Massachusetts, also known as Fran, is only facilitating the ear cropping procedure. The buyer releases the seller from any complications and/or liabilities, whether financial or medical, that may occur before, during, or after the procedure. This release encompasses, but is not limited to: All facets of the surgery, including the duration of stay at the surgical facility Transportation to and from the facility . Care of the puppy by the seller prior to and following the surgery.

The buyer understands that any surgical procedure, especially those involving general anesthesia, carries inherent risks, including complications or even death. Additionally, the buyer agrees not to hold the seller responsible for, but not limited to:

- Any unexpected additional costs - Any unforeseen medical procedures related to or resulting from the surgery-Ear infections-The aesthetic results of the ears (size and shape)-Ears not standing erect (either one or both).The buyer agrees to pay a sum of \$1,000.00 for the ear cropping surgery by the time the puppy reaches one week of age. This payment is specifically for the ear cropping and is not a deposit for the puppy. Should there be any additional expenses related to the puppy, the buyer agrees to settle these costs promptly upon receipt of the ear cropping surgery bill. It is crucial for the buyer to be completely satisfied with the decision to crop the puppy's ears. Please be aware that ear cropping fees are non-refundable once the appointment is confirmed, as the veterinarian's schedule is reserved specifically for the puppy's surgery, and the payment is necessary to secure that appointment.
